Datatex is a "frequent" exhibitor at ITMA. It has demonstrated its Business Software Solutions specialized for textile industries in all ITMA editions starting from Paris in 1987. A common pattern of datatex presence at ITMA is the number of demos run using the real software to show to the visitors how to enter a sales order checking on/line the delivery date or how to track the materials at all levels of inventory along the supply chain.

This year there is a great innovation, tuned with the ITMA slogan. For the first time the demos are performed without having installed a system. A set of Personal Computers are connected via the Internet to the system in Milan, and they demonstrate the datatex solution using the real application installed remotely. Moreover all the screens are Presented in the very own language of the ITMA visitor. It is enough to upload the <browser> (e.g. Internet Explorer) on the visitor-s language that the datatex solution recognizes it and presents the screens in that specific language. Therefore at datatex stand you can see a desk with a screen showing a planning and scheduling function in Chinese close to one presenting a warehouse management report in Spanish or in English and even right to left in Arabic.

Datatex takes ITMA very seriously as the place of innovation considering it as the ideal stage to present the most advanced ERP Enterprise Resources Planning solution available for the textile industries.

Fully Web/base, compliant to the most important standards J2EE and XML, designed as SOA Service Oriented Architecture, the datatex solution fits the requirements of any textile company, whether small mill specialized in a single step of the textile process or large integrated company covering most of the production chain.
